

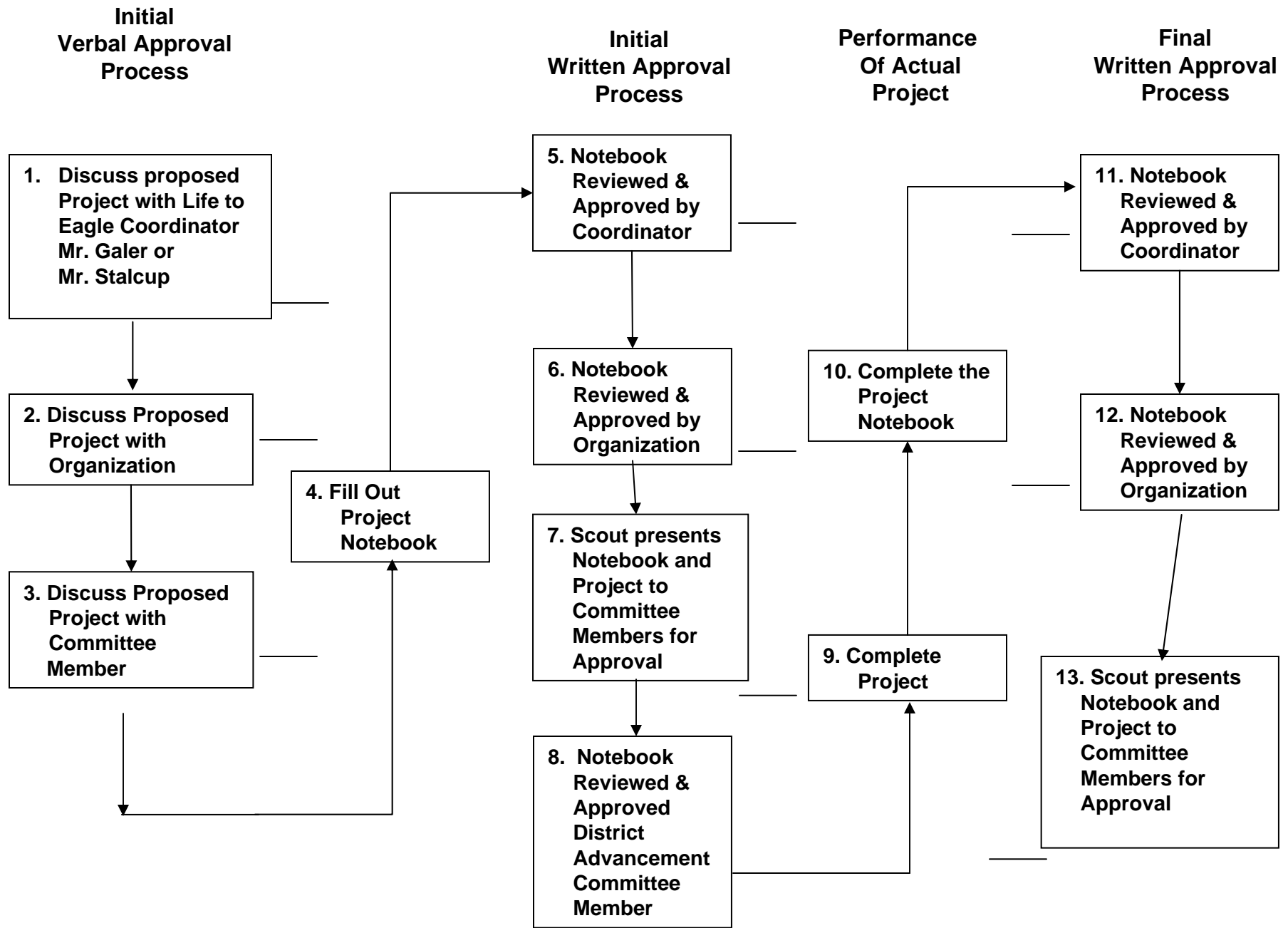
Life to Eagle Process

1. Complete all badges (boy)
2. Complete service project (details to follow)
3. Get printout from Troopmaster of all advancement (boy gets from Advancement Chairman)
4. Fill out Eagle Application (boy)
 - a. Scout asks five people who are willing to write reference letters prior to putting their information on the application; provides self-addressed stamped envelope to be mailed to Scoutmaster.
 - b. Write a life statement as required in the application
5. Schedule a Scoutmaster Conference (boy)
6. Once the Conference is complete, Scoutmaster sends out letters asking for recommendations
7. Once letters arrive, Advancement Chair schedules a Board of Review
8. Once Board of Review is complete, Advancement Chair brings completed application to Bethesda and waits for award
9. Publicity chair sends out requests for commendation letters
10. Plan Court of Honor

Project Process

1. Boy thinks of an idea. He may go talk to an organization about this idea, or he may talk to his Life to Eagle Advisor. Once the Advisor hears of the idea, he instructs the boy to write it up in paragraph form.
2. Boy submits his idea in a paragraph. Advisor approves idea (or makes some modifications) and gives instruction to the boy to write it up in the workbook format.
3. Boy works with Advisor until the workbook meets the requirements of a good plan that will be signed off by District.
4. Once Advisor approves, boy meets with the organization that will benefit from the project and gets their representative to sign it.
5. Next the boy meets with the Committee Chair (and Committee Rep) to obtain his review and signature
5. Next the boy meets with the District representative for the same
6. Boy schedules the project date with the Committee Chair's and Scoutmaster's concurrence
7. Complete the project
8. Complete final writeup – same iterative process as the initial plan
9. Advisor, Organization, Committee, and District representative sign off
